FACULTY-LED PROGRAMS

Study Abroad: Step-by-Step

I: Application Phase

- Research faculty-led study abroad options to find the course that fits your personal and academic interests by visiting abroad.okstate.edu
- Apply for scholarships through your college and the Center for Global Learning.
 - Contact the course program's coordinator if you have any questions about the course: price, dates, academic content, location, application procedures, etc.
- Apply online through the course's digital brochure, via the faculty-led website of the college that is coordinating the program.

Complete all application steps and wait for confirmation of your acceptance.

II: Pre-Departure Phase

- Attend orientation and other required meetings to prepare for your course
- Ensure your passport is valid 6 months after your return date
- Meet your academic advisor to ensure credits earned will apply to your degree
- Review health and safety information about the location(s) of the program.
- Review any vaccination requirements for your location and course
- Follow all instructions provided by the program coordinator & faculty leaders

III: Abroad Phase

Considerations While Abroad

- Keep all important documents (passport, visa, insurance) in a secure location
- Keep track of expenses via budgeting, etc
- Be aware of and follow health and safety guidelines.
- *(optional)* consider partaking in an Instagram take-over with the Center for Global Learning while abroad



IV: Returnee

- Attend any required debrief or re-entry class meetings.
- Submit any required evaluations or course assignments to your instructor to obtain credits.
