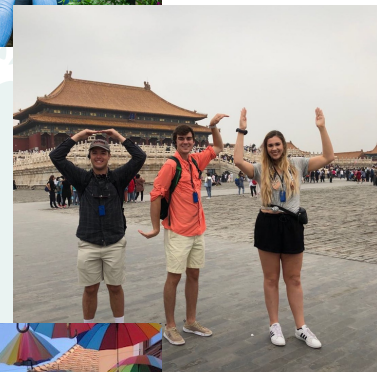


Short-Term Faculty-Led Programs



What is a Faculty-Led Program?

Are you looking for an immersive, educational experience and a way to get outside your comfort zone? Faculty-led courses are designed for OSU students seeking to quickly expand their global perspective. They take you beyond the ordinary to **immerse yourself in a new country, language, and culture**. Faculty-led courses **serve every major**, so every student will find a course that fits with their academic plan. This means you can travel around the world while satisfying major requirements, experiencing the culture of your travel destination, and making lasting friendships and connections with your classmates. Courses occur during **winter intersession, spring break, and the summer** and vary each semester but may include components during the semester. **There is an opportunity for everyone!**



Locations

Want to study culture and industry in **France**? Or business in **Iceland**? What about sustainable development in **Singapore**? Faculty-led courses are the best way! Courses and locations vary by college and year and examples include Zimbabwe, France, Mexico, Dubai, & Costa Rica.



Benefits

- You can participate as a **freshman, sophomore, junior, senior, or graduate student**.
- **3 credit hours** are usually earned for each faculty-led study abroad course.
- Courses are **short**, typically between one and three weeks in length.
- **Employers** welcome signs of acceptance of challenges.
- Teaches the value of **diversity** and an understanding of different cultures.

Funding & Deadlines

Individual college **application deadlines can differ**. Plan to apply at least six to eight months prior to your course. OSU awards **over \$850k in scholarships annually** to students for study abroad courses. You can apply for scholarships through the Center for Global Learning and your individual college.
