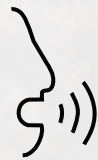

## How It Works

Students can study at OSU's international partner universities for a semester or an academic year, while staying enrolled at Oklahoma State University.

During the exchange, students continue to pay tuition and fees to OSU at the **same tuition rate** they normally pay, but all housing, meals and other costs are paid in the host country.

Most scholarships and financial aid apply as they would for courses taught on the home campus. Students receive OSU residential credit.

Majority of international partners have courses offered in English.

The priority application deadline is at the end of January for the upcoming fall semester, spring semester, and academic year.






# AFFILIATED/ APPROVED PARTNERS

## How It Works

Opportunities include short-term, semester or academic year exchanges at locations across the world. You can take a variety of courses that can be applied to your degree plan.

It generally costs more to participate in an affiliated approved program than a reciprocal exchange as affiliated programs often offer additional amenities.

Some programs may include housing, food, local transportation, excursions, and on-site academic centers.

# NATIONAL STUDENT EXCHANGE

## How It Works

As the only university in Oklahoma that participates in this “study away” program, OSU sends students to Hawaii, Alaska, Guam and even the U.S. Virgin Islands! The National Student Exchange (NSE) is made up of over 190 universities in the United States, U.S. Territories, and Canada. 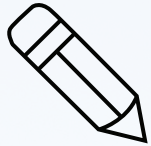
